Areas of Expertise

Leadership Development

- Overarching: Fostering leadership through developmental experiences
- Specific focus areas:
 - Interpersonal skills (e.g., listening, communication, values, empathy, perception, conflict, strengths, growth mindset)
 - Generativity (i.e., care and concern for the next generation)
 - Leader/leadership identity development (i.e., How do we see ourselves as leaders? How can we strengthen our view of ourselves as capable of enacting change?)

Leadership Education

- Overarching: Creating and assessing developmental interventions
- Specific focus areas:
 - Meaning-making (e.g., reflection, debrief) in educational experiences
 - Building, refining, and evaluating mentoring programs
 - Utilizing needs assessments to create interventions
 - Integrating a variety of techniques (e.g., degree-ofchange methodology) to assess and evaluate programs

Team Science

- Overarching: Promoting successful and cohesive groups and teams by strengthening skills and establishing processes
- Specific focus areas:
 - Understanding the stages of team development, especially navigating "storming" or conflict
 - Building group norms and processes
